### Setting Up Your Student Accounts and Technology

Activate your Tufts username (UTLN).

Set up your Tufts email account, the official communication method with university faculty and staff.

Access our Student Information System (SIS) to register for classes, view your account balance, request official transcripts, and more.

**Log into Canvas**, our primary learning platform at Tufts, to access course syllabi and materials, and begin connecting with professors and peers.

For 24/7 IT support, please visit the **Technology Services** portal and reach out via email, phone, or submit a request.

## **Ordering Your Transcripts**

Official transcripts from all the post-secondary institutions where you earned credit toward an undergraduate, graduate, or professional degree are required before you can register for classes. To be considered official, transcripts must be sent directly from the institution or a third-party transcript service to Tufts.


